The Director, CSIR-NML intends to engage Graduate Apprentice Trainees as well as Technician Apprentice Trainees through Walk-in-Interview as per the scheme provided under the Apprenticeship Act, 1961 and the Apprenticeship Rules, 1992 of Government of India, as per details mentioned below:

MINIMUM ESSENTIAL EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

For Graduate (Degree) Apprentice Trainees: 4 years regular B.E/B.Tech Degree obtained from a recognized University/ Institutions in relevant discipline mentioned in the above table.

For Technician Apprentice Trainees: 3 years regular Diploma in Engineering/Technology obtained from a State Council or Board of Technical Education Established by a State Government/University/Institutions in relevant discipline mentioned in the above table.

OTHER ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

1. Only those candidates are eligible who have passed the Degree / Diploma during the years 2020/2021/2022/2023/2024/2025
2. The candidates should NOT have undergone any apprenticeship training earlier or pursuing Apprenticeship Training as per the Apprentices Act, 1961/1973 as amended from time to time;
3. **Each Candidate must have verified 16-Digit NATS ID;**
4. In case the date of declaration of result is not mentioned in the Mark Sheet, the candidate must submit a certificate mentioning the date of publication of result issued by the Principal of the Polytechnic / College / Institute from where the candidate pursued his / her Diploma / Degree course, along with application form;
5. One candidate can apply against any one of the discipline;

AGE LIMIT:

- For Technician Apprenticeship: Minimum 18 years and maximum 24 years as on the date of interview;
- For Graduate/Degree Apprenticeship: Minimum 21 years and maximum 26 years as on date of interview
- Relaxation in upper age limit: Relaxation by 5 years for SC/ST, 3 years for OBC (NCL), for the posts reserved for them). Candidates belonging to PwBD Categories shall be given age relaxation up to 10 years (up to 15 years for SC/ST and up to 13 years for OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) Candidates.

RESERVATION OF VACANCIES:

Guidelines under Apprentices Act on reservation for SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/PwBD will be followed. Those who are claiming reservation under SC/ST/OBC/PwBD shall produce certificate issued by appropriate authority in the format prescribed by Govt. of India, failing which they will be considered as 'General' category candidates only, if otherwise eligible.

Period of Apprenticeship Training: 12 months

APPRENTICESHIP REGISTRATION: Candidates are advised to register as Graduate (Degree)/ Technician (Diploma) Apprentices online in the following portal under the respective State as per their trades in Graduate (Degree)/ Technician (Diploma) Apprentices: <https://nats.education.gov.in> / www.bopter.gov.in

- For candidates who have not so far enrolled in the National Web Portal {Technician (Diploma)/ Graduate (Degree) Apprentices}:
 - a. Go to: <https://nats.education.gov.in/>;
 - b. Click on Student – Student Register;
 - c. Complete the application form;
 - d. A Unique Student Enrolment ID for each student will be generated after successful registration which is mandatory before applying for the positions and need to be mentioned in the application form.

PLACE OF TRAINING: CSIR-NML, Jamshedpur.

Interested and eligible candidates may appear in the walk-in-interview with following documents in original along with one set of self-attested photocopies thereof in support of their claims of eligibility / qualification, category etc.:

1. 10th / Matriculation certificate / marks sheet – for proof of date of birth as mentioned in the application for;
2. Certificate and Marks sheet of BE / B.Tech. or Diploma, as the case may be;
3. Caste Certificate [for SC/ST/OBC (Non Creamy Layer) candidates (as the case may be) in the prescribed format issued by the Competent Authority as prescribed by Government of India;
4. PwBD certificate, if any;
5. Two recent passport size colour photograph;
6. Adhar card / PAN card or any other Government issued photo ID proof.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- i. Candidates must register with BOPT, through the website <http://www.bopter.gov.in>. Please thoroughly peruse <http://www.bopter.gov.in> for details of the scheme.
- ii. Selections for engagement of Apprenticeship trainees would be based on discipline wise merit list which will be drawn on the basis of their performance before the Committee in the walk-in-interview;
- iii. Candidates are advised to ensure that they are medically fit as per medical standard required for the concerned discipline, failing which their candidature is liable to be cancelled.

ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE OF PROFICIENCY (COP):

Every Graduate & Technician apprentice, who completes his/her apprenticeship training to the satisfaction of the concerned Regional Board (Eastern Region in this case) shall be granted a "certificate of proficiency" by that Board on behalf of Central Govt.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- i. CSIR-NML shall have no obligation to give regular employment to Apprentices. The Apprentices shall have no right to claim regular employment from CSIR-NML / CSIR or any of its Institutes /

Laboratories on the basis of this apprenticeship training at any point of time. This apprenticeship training shall not create any liability on CSIR-NML for providing any job to the Apprentice.

- ii. **Cut Off date for all eligibility / relaxation:** 31.10.2025.
- iii. Candidates with qualification acquired through Distance Learning Mode of Part Time Mode or Correspondence Mode shall not be considered.
- iv. Wherever CGPA/ OGPA or Letter Grade is awarded in the Diploma/ Degree examination, its equivalent aggregate percentage of marks must be mentioned in the application form as per the norms adopted by concerned University/ Institute.
- v. Candidates possessing higher professional qualifications such as B.E or equivalent (for technician apprentices), M.Tech or equivalent (for graduate apprentices) shall not be considered.
- vi. Suppression of information regarding possession or pursuing higher qualification and / or already have undergone any such apprenticeship, shall render a candidate ineligible for consideration at any stage of engagement process and apprenticeship may be terminated at any time during engagement as well;
- vii. The candidates who are selected as Apprentice must possess an Aadhar linked Bank Account in his/her own name preferably in a nationalized bank with internet banking facilities and PAN card to receive stipend from CSIR-NML;
- viii. If the number of candidates is more, the Selection Committee may adopt its own criteria like conducting a written test etc. to shortlist the candidates to appear in the walk-in- interview;
- ix. No accommodation will be provided. Selected candidates will have to make their own arrangements for stay during their engagement;
- x. Any corrigendum/addendum or updates with regard to this advertisement shall be available through CSIR-NML website <https://nml.res.in> only. Candidates are advised to regularly visit CSIR-NML website for updates on screening / selection etc.;
- xi. Any applicant's candidature would be provisional and subject to subsequent verification of certificates and testimonials. In case, it is detected at any stage of engagement or thereafter, that a candidate does not fulfill the eligibility norms and/or that he/she has furnished any incorrect/ doctored/false information/certificate/documents or has suppressed any material fact(s), his/her candidature will stand cancelled. If any of these shortcomings is/are detected even after engagement, if any, his/her engagement is liable to be terminated;
- xii. The decision of the Competent Authority, CSIR-NML will be final and binding on all candidates on all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the applications, mode of selection, cancellation of the selection process either in part or full, etc. No correspondence/ Interim queries will be entertained in this regard. Filling up of the seats is solely at the discretion of the Competent Authority, CSIR-NML based on suitability of candidates and no claim will arise for engagement, if some of these seats are not filled due to unsuitability/ insufficient number of candidates;
- xiii. The number of seats in each of the disciplines are provisional and may vary, either increase or decrease at the time of actual selection or may be cancelled also on the discretion of the competent authority,

- CSIR-NML which will be binding on all the concerned.
- xiv. Canvassing in any form and /or bringing in any influence, political or otherwise will be treated as a disqualification.
- xv. The candidate must have an active email ID and a Mobile Number.
